## Praying for God's World

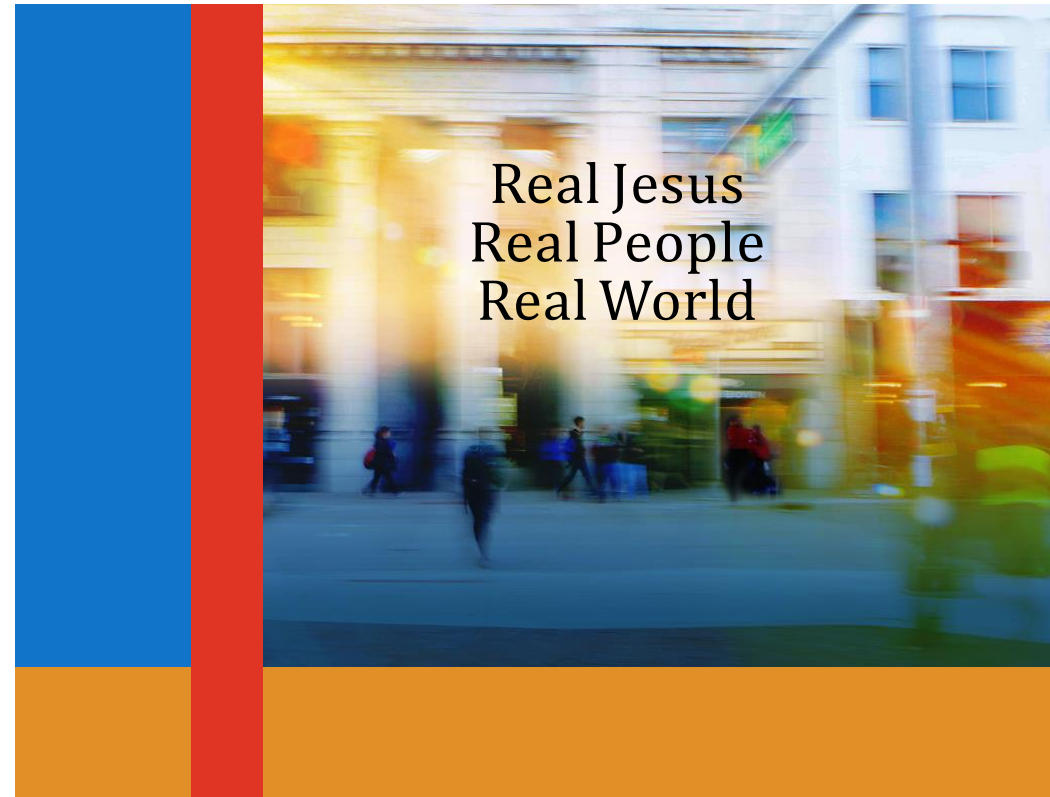
