DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- Why was the Samaritan woman surprised that Jesus spoke to her?
- What did the Samaritan woman's face look like when she first saw Jesus sitting at the well? What did her face look like by the end of the story? What caused this change?
- Just as Jesus knew everything about the Samaritan woman and still loved her, He also knows everything about you. What difference does that make in your life? Why does it matter that Jesus knows you completely and loves you?
- What does it mean when Jesus says He can give us living water? When have you felt refreshed by Him?
- By talking to the Samaritan woman, Jesus showed that His kingdom would bring together people who were different—even groups of people that disliked each other. Think of someone in your life who might seem very different from you, maybe someone that you struggle to like. Then ask Jesus to give you His love for that person and show you how to be a friend to him or her.
