

Outdoor Worship Procedures During Coronavirus

Please read each time as procedures may have changed

In advance of outdoor worship

Please feel free to join outdoor worship if you

- Are free of coronavirus symptoms
- Have not traveled to a heavy-virus zone in the past two weeks or have been exposed to someone known to have the virus
- Have pre-registered and received confirmation of your participation
- Have read the following description of worship procedures
- Please
 - Print out a bulletin at home or bring an electronic device, if you like.
 - Pack masks if you want to wear them. Masks are optional for outdoor worship.
 - Pack lawn chairs and anything that will help you manage the weather - hat, water bottles... If you bring an umbrella, please sit as far to the rear as possible.
 - Allow extra time so that you can be seated and ready to worship at 11:00 AM.

Arriving for Outdoor worship

Please

- PARK IN THE UPPER LOT, entering from either the lower or upper drive.
- Drivers may drop off those with mobility issues close to the seating area and then park.
- Stop at the end of the driveway. A Greeter will give you parking directions.
- Make your way toward the seating area; pick up communion elements from a table and drop off your tithes and offerings, if you like.
- Follow directions from a Welcome Team member. You will be directed to set up your chairs in every other parking spot in the center section of the upper parking lot.
- Walk socially distanced to your seating area; be aware of electric cords or pavement hazards.
- Tents may be available on the grass. Feel free to ask Welcome Team members about sitting under them.

During in-person worship

Please

- Limit movement and use restrooms only if necessary. Please ask a Welcome Team member to assist you into the building. Parents must accompany young children.
- Keep your children with you and properly physically distanced at all times.
- Cough into your elbow or exit the area if you have a coughing spell.

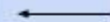
After worship
