



Indoor Worship Procedures During Coronavirus

Updated April 15, 2021

Please feel free to join indoor worship if you:

- Are free of coronavirus symptoms
- Have not traveled to a heavy-virus zone in the past two weeks, or been exposed to someone known to have the virus
- Have registered via Sign-up Genius
- Have read the following description of indoor worship procedures and agreed to comply

In advance of indoor worship

- Printed bulletins are available in the Worship Center. But, you may like to print a bulletin at home or bring an electronic device. The order of service will be projected on the screens.
- Pack masks for everyone attending worship with you.
- Leave home early to allow extra time so that you can be seated and ready to worship by 9:30 AM. Ushers will begin seating people at 9:00 AM.

Arriving for Indoor worship

- Park on the [upper level and enter through the canopy doors](#).
- [Wear your mask](#). (If you forget your mask, one will be provided for you.)
- Proceed to the Worship Center. Sit where an Usher directs you, safely physically distanced from others beginning at the front of the Worship Center. Thank you for your flexibility because you may not be able to sit in your usual spot.
- Note that receptacles for your tithes and offerings are located by each entrance to the Worship Center.
- Remember there is no Children's Worship or Nursery care. A designated area is open for nursing mothers of non-mobile infants in the Nursery/Toddler 1 area.

During in-person worship

- Cough into your elbow or exit the room if you have a coughing spell.
- Limit movement and use restrooms only if necessary. Parents must accompany young children. Keep your children with you and properly physically distanced at all times.
- Do not sit in the Atrium.

After worship

- Exit as directed by the Ushers.
- Visit with others outdoors, properly physically distanced.

Additional information of interest

- If you become symptomatic or test positive for COVID between attending Sunday worship and Tuesday at noon, please call 734.904.2572. You will be asked to identify all individuals with whom you had close contact (more than 15 minutes while less than 6 feet apart, even if masked). Knox will share those names with the Washtenaw County Health Department for possible contact tracing.
- Hand sanitizing stations will be set up for use before and after the worship service.
- Bathrooms are cleaned and disinfected before the worship service.
- Drinking fountains, food and drink will return in the future.
- Seating arrangements will accommodate a 6' physical separation between individuals, couples or families.
