

Paul's love and deep concern for Christ's body is evident throughout these two short but dynamic letters. These epistles fill us with a sense of hope and anticipation for the second coming of Jesus and the establishment of his everlasting kingdom. We are given a call to be prepared for the return of our Lord, to stand firm, and to grow rightly in our faith. What a timely message for all of us living in these days!

Each week participants are encouraged to prepare in advance for the large group discussion guided by readings in Thessalonians and questions in Kathleen Nielson's study guide. Table group time will allow for further discussion, application, fellowship, and prayer.


